



Scholarships, Events, Opportunities...

- 1. BGSU**- New freshmen scholarships ranging from \$1,000-\$5,000. You must have at least a 3.0 cum. GPA and a 20 on the ACT. These rewards are renewable if you maintain a 3.0. If you qualify for the \$5,000 award, you may also be considered for the full-tuition scholarship. To qualify for one of the 50 full-tuition scholarships, the FAFSA must be filed by January 1 20012. These scholarships are automatic. Just fill out the application for BGSU. For more information, go to <http://choose.bgsu.edu/aid/scholarships>.
- 2. Ohio Northern University**- If you have at least a 3.3 cum GPA and a 25 ACT composite, you are eligible for the Dean's Scholarship (\$6,000-\$13,000). Several additional scholarships are available. Pharmacy students must meet different criteria to be eligible for scholarships. Call 1-888-408-4668 or go to www.onu.edu for details.
- 3. The University of Akron**- The Honors College offers the for opportunity to live in the Honors Complex and be considered for various scholarships as well as study abroad or participate in undergraduate research. Apply on-line at www.uakron.edu/honors by November 1st.



24. University of Toledo- Scholarship Program: Must have a 3.0 and have taken the ACT to be eligible. Apply at utoledo.edu!


